We would like to use this opportunity to share information about the types of jobs, income, benefits, and opportunities for growth and development that these careers provide.

The tour will start with a light breakfast and presentation at WCC. The kickoff will include a tour of their advanced manufacturing labs and equipment along with a discussion of possible career pathways. After that we will get back on the bus and visit two local manufacturing facilities for tours and presentations on their companies and the opportunities available in the manufacturing workforce including the New York State apprenticeship program.
